APPLICATION CHARACTERISTIC AND ADVANTAGES

Coadd™ DF-6633 is recommended for water-borne acrylic/polyurethane-based applications in high gloss emulsion systems, printing ink and overprint varnishes, with relatively low PVC. It can also be used in aqueous UV systems. It can be added in any stage during production, recommended to divide between grinding and letdown stage. Separation may occur after storage, mix well before use.

Suggested dosage (base on the total formulation): 0.1 - 1%.

Optimum level of dosage should be determined via laboratory tests.
